Lakeland ATV Club 2019 Trail/Route Review

Price County, the towns of Emery and Fifield opened all of their town roads for ATV use. Before the Towns opening all Roads the Lakeland Club only had a corridor Route through these two Townships out to the Sailor Lake area.

Town of Arbor Vitae, This year saw a new Trail/Route from Airport Rd south to Terry Lane and then south to the businesses around the intersection of Hwy 70 east and Hwy 51 north. Kwik Trip, Heart Two and the others in that area. In November the Town of Arbor Vitae decided to open all of its Town Roads to ATV/UTV use. There are a few that are closed and are marked as such. This will go into effect May of 2020. Also in May of 2020 when Vilas County opens trails an East West Trail/Route will open through the NHAL State Forest. The trail starts at the intersection of Hwy 51 north and North Framing Rd. It then goes East to where it intersects with Witches Lake Rd and Ross Lake Rd.

Town of Minocqua, eight Town Roads were opened in the Town of Minocqua. Eight more are going through the Petition process that is required in the Town of Minocqua.

Town of Woodruff, the Town of Woodruff also has all town roads open. There are a few that closed and are marked as such. A 2.5 mile section of trail was opened midsummer on the Rail Road grade paralleling Hwy 47 from Woodruff Rd. and Gritzmachen Rd. From Gritzmachen you can access Lake Tomahawk.

NHAL State Forest, the Lakeland Club has been working with the DNR, Oneida, and Vilas Counties to open a Trail/Route from the Hwy 47 RR grade trail north to the Sayner area. We are hoping this will open sometime in the summer of 2020. This Trail/Route would intersect the East West Trail/Route talked about earlier.

2019 was a busy year for the Lakeland Club. I would like to thank all that help make all these projects happen. I am optimistically looking forward to the 2020 season.
