

MAY 1, 2019 TRAILS/ROUTES OPENING NOTICE

The summer routes (town roads) in the towns of Arbor Vitae, Minocqua, and Woodruff were opened on May 1, 2019. In the towns of Arbor Vitae and Woodruff the routes will be open, however you will not be able to use the connector trail between the towns until Vilas County opens the trail system in the county. This will not happen until the frost is out of the ground and the county can inspect the trails and at that time they will declare them open. The RR grade trail along Hwy 47, the Park & Rides on Hwy 47 north and Hwy 70 east will not be opened until inspected and declared open by the county. You **CAN NOT** ride out of these parking areas until Vilas County opens the funded trails. The funded Trails in Oneida County are also not open until the frost is out and they have been inspected.

PLEASE do not abuse the privilege of the use of these routes and trails and realize that the towns can shut down the routes if abused. Also please let others know about what is going on with the late opening and we are asking for your **HELP** protecting the use of the routes and trails.

We are looking for Volunteers for our annual road cleanup that will be held on Saturday May 18th, 2019 starting at 9am. We will be meeting at the Manhardt Rd. Park and Ride which is one mile east of the four corner intersection of Pine Lake Rd. Price County Rd, Manhardt Rd, and Willow Rd. The town of Minocqua will supply Vests and Garbage Bags.
